



Library is 2010 Census Partner

Anyone needing assistance with completing 2010 census forms can get help at the Main Library in Winnsboro. A census worker is available during the following times to assist individuals in completing the questionnaire:

Monday, Tuesday & Saturday: 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Thursday: 5:00 to 8:00 p.m. Friday: 12:00 noon to 3:00 p.m.

If you did not receive a census questionnaire in the mail, or know of someone who did not, you can pick up forms at the library.

Everybody counts! You can help bring dollars for services into Fairfield County by participating in the census. For example, State Aid to public libraries is distributed based on county population.

Keep your fingers crossed!

Two things have happened that have increased the possibility of moving forward with the library's expansion project.

The first piece of good news is a new, very favorable estimate for the cost of the expansion project. In January, 2008, architect Danny Shelley estimated a total project cost of \$4.92 million. This covered new construction, renovation of existing space, furniture and shelving, professional fees, and other contingency costs. Because of the changes in the construction market in recent months, the library asked Mr. Shelley to update his project estimate. His revised estimate just received this month is for a total project cost of \$3.57 million. While it's been frustrating that our expansion has not moved forward over the past several years, it is now obvious that was a beneficial thing! The major cost saving results from a reduction in per square foot building costs. Library shelving is now on state contract which results in

savings on equipment as well.

While it is exciting to have such a favorable estimate, we are still a long way from having the funds in hand to move ahead. The library has about \$80,000 in our Building Fund, and we have about \$80,000 in grant funds committed through Senator Lindsay Graham.

However, the second piece of good news is the possibility of stimulus funding through the US Department of Agriculture. These loan/grant funds are specifically designated for library construction. Competition will be strong, but we are working with the county to develop an application for our expansion project. Now would be a great time to remind your elected officials how much an expanded library facility would benefit the county.

BY THE NUMBERS

SC LENDS has been in operation with its full component of ten libraries since early December, 2009. Books and other materials have been traveling between libraries at an astounding rate since then.

Library has lent 1,115 items to other libraries. In return we have borrowed 386 items from other libraries for Fairfield County Library patrons.

The total items lent among **SC LENDS** libraries for December-February was 51,972.

As a follow-up to his acclaimed performance as Francis Marion, this "historian of many personalities" will bring national

statesman and South Carolina governor James F. Byrnes to life.

Byrnes, 1879-1972, was the 104th governor of South Carolina. Prior to that he served in the US House of

Representatives, in the the US Senate, as a US Supreme Court Justice, and as Secretary of State. As a confidant of President Franklin Roosevelt, Byrnes was one of the most powerful men in American domestic and foreign policy in the mid-1940s.

A short business meeting will precede the program and refreshments will follow.
